

## NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS (F.Y 2022-23)

### A) FOOD WING of Drugs & Food Control Organization, J&K

- ❑ **Food Safety Index 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23.** Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir secured first rank among the UT category in Food Safety Index 3<sup>rd</sup> time in a row. (Awarded on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2021, 2022 and 2023).
- ❑ **Implementation of Eat Right Initiatives:** The department has successfully implemented all the FSSAI Initiatives under Eat Right India Movement in the Year 2022-23, under which 162 License/Registration Melas, 43 FoSTaC Training Programmes, 588 Certifications under Hygiene Rating of Hotels/Restaurants/Dhabas/Meat Shops/Sweets Shops, 50 Certifications under Eat Right Campuses (including Hospitals, Jails, Govt. Institutions etc), 07 Certifications under Eat Right Places of Worship, 15 Certifications under Eat Right School have been achieved.
- ❑ The UT of J&K has the distinction of being the only UT/State to have organised Eat Right Mela/Walkathons across all the districts, for which 1<sup>st</sup> Prize and certification has been awarded.
- ❑ **FoSCoS (Food Safety Compliance System):** The department has successfully implemented FoSCoS in the UT of J&K, where under all the sampling and inspections are being done online and uploaded through the portal. J&K has done record number of 29342 Inspections.
- ❑ **INFoLNeT (Indian Food Laboratory Network):** The department has implemented INFoLNeT in both the FTLs, to introduce a transparent, accountable report generating system, wherein the Food testing Laboratories have shifted all its analytical work to online mode.
- ❑ **Eat Right Challenge-2:** 12 Districts of the UT participated in the ER Challenge-II. All the 12 featured in top 100 Districts across the country, with District Kishtwar, Budgam and Bandipora leading the top 03 in the UT.
- ❑ **Toll-free Number:** The department has established Help Desk with Toll Free Number (104) for the consumers for having a robust grievance redressal system.

## **B) DRUG WING of Drugs & Food Control Organization, J&K**

- ❑ CCTV cameras and adoption of fully computerized billing system in all the medical sale establishments has been made mandatory while seeking regulatory clearances. This step has been initiated to curb menace of drug / substance abuse by maintaining surveillance over the dispensing practices in the pharmacies. This can further help to stop pilferage / illicit use of habit forming drugs in the supply chain of drugs.
- ❑ A substantial number of pharmacies have adopted the above directives. However, in some rural areas, the constraints of power backup and non-availability of broadband services is posing some resistance.

### **Nasha Mukht Abhiyaan----Awareness campaign thereof.**

- ❑ Drug & Food Control Organization has already started conducting awareness programmes at District Level by involving all stakeholders. The pharma trade fraternity is being educated /sensitized through these awareness programmes that all the habit forming pharmaceutical preparations should be dispensed strictly in accordance with the conditions of the drug sale licences.
- ❑ The department has also decided to adopt a zero tolerance approach to counter unregulated sale of HABIT FORMING DRUGS in the larger interest of a drug free society. In case any pharma trader indulges in willful omission / breach with respect to purchase / sale of these drugs, the drug sale license's of such dealers is cancelled with immediate effect.
- ❑ Since April, 2022 to till date almost 500 drug sale licenses have been disallowed by the enforcement staff of the organization. The reasons for suspension ranged from Non-maintenance of Sales record, Impersonation, Unhygienic/Unsanitary Conditions, Improper storage conditions etc.
